An exciting event is being planned for the children of Colorado on **February 18**. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is a regional-sponsored event to assist local churches in involving children in ministry. This event will be held at **Thrive Church, 2820 W 92nd Avenue, Federal Heights, CO 80260**.

The main goal of the Festival is to encourage children to know, even though they are young, that God can use them to minister to others. They will be able to participate in as many as three **Presentation Ministries**, such as singing, playing instruments, drama, human video, clowning, and short sermon. Also, participants may be involved in **Creation Ministries**, such as writing, drawing, and many others. Please review the enclosed packet for more information about this wonderful opportunity for the children of your church.

Once your children have decided which category(ies) to enter, complete the registration forms. Make a copy of each of the forms for your records and send the originals to: Childrens Ministries, Rocky Mountain District, 6295 Lehman Dr. #202, Colorado Springs, CO 80918. The cost of the festival is \$8 for each participant for the first event/category plus \$4 for each additional event/category the participant would like to enter. Please make one check per church payable to the Rocky Mountain District. Everyone must pre-register by February 9. No late registrations will be accepted after February 9 due to scheduling purposes. When you arrive at the Festival, you will be given a schedule showing what times your children will be ministering.

It is important that all participants carefully read the guidelines for each category. Children are given specific instructions to follow which will help them as they prepare to minister. Judges will be referred to as "**coaches**" because, as they evaluate, they will be "coaching" the children by their positive comments and suggestions.

At the Celebration service every child will receive a certificate with a seal of *good, excellent, or superior*. They will also take home three evaluation forms to remind them how to continue to develop their ministry skills.

I hope you will make every effort to encourage the children of your church to participate in the Junior Fine Arts Festival. With God's help, together we can prepare the next generation of ministers.

2012 Guidelines

Age: The age for the Junior Fine Arts Festival is children in 1st – 6th grade.

Theme

This year's theme is "What a Wonderful God!" Romans 11:33-36 is the Bible reference. This theme should be reflected in Drama, Art, and Writing. There will not be a designated theme for the Music Division or Creative Movement Division.

Bible Memorization Scripture

This year's Bible memorization passage is Psalms 147:1-5 followed by Romans 11:33-36. If the New International Version (NIV) is not used, please bring three copies of your version for the coaches.

Dress Code

Appropriate dress is required for all categories. Please dress modestly with ministry effectiveness in mind, to glorify Christ.

General Rules

1. It is the responsibility of each parent and/or adult sponsor to be familiar with the guidelines. A parent and/or adult sponsor's signature on the registration form indicates that he/she has read and will abide by the guidelines stated.
2. There must be at least one adult per every eight children from each church represented.
3. All content used for any entry must be Christian in theme and taste. (*Exception: Instrumental Division. We realize students at this age may not play "Christian" songs in school band. Only in this division will a student be allowed to use non-Christian music.*)
4. Students using sound tracks can have backup voices, but students cannot sing a song or "lip sync" with the main singer's voice.
5. All performances from start to finish will have a five to seven minute time limit. The participants will be given up to three minutes to set up prior to their performance.
6. In group entries, one substitution may be made in case of an emergency. Omissions of persons may be allowed at the Festival; however, additions are not allowed.
7. No individual or individuals within a group may register for more than one entry in the same category of a division. The total number of **presentation categories** a participant may enter is limited to three. However, a child may enter as many **creation ministries** as he/she chooses.
8. Festival participants should always be mindful of their representation of Christ in regard to their behavior.
9. Festival participants will be expected to be on time for their scheduled performances. If a student is not on time, he/she will be skipped. If there is additional time after all performances, the student may be permitted to perform.
10. Be courteous to other participants. Do not enter the performance room when a student is performing. Students need to be with their leaders during the Festival.

2012 Ministry Categories

Ministry categories are not intended to be all-inclusive of any talent available. They are intended to represent the most prevalent ministries, as well as those ministries most easily utilized by children. An exciting event is being planned for the children of Eastern Colorado. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is a regional-sponsored event to assist local churches in involving children in ministry. The main goal of the Festival is to encourage children to know, even though they are young, that God can use them to minister to others.

They will be able to participate in many **Presentation Ministry** categories, such as singing, playing instruments, drama, human video, creative movement, object lesson, Bible memorization, puppetry, clowning, and short sermon. Also, participants may be involved in **Creation Ministries** categories, such as writing, drawing, sewing, baking, science, painting, collages, missions display, photography, and many others.

Prior to the Festival, children will be given specific guidelines to follow which will help them as they prepare to minister. Judges will be referred to as "coaches" because, as they evaluate, they will be "coaching" the children by their positive comments and suggestions. *This is not intended to be a contest where children compete against each other. Instead each child will be evaluated by the standards recommended for his or her category.*

The Festival will conclude with a Celebration service where every child will receive a certificate with a seal of *good, excellent, or superior*. They will also take home their three evaluation forms to remind them how to continue to develop their ministry skills. One entry from each ministry category will be chosen to perform during the ending Celebration service.

Once your child has decided which category(ies) to enter, complete the attached registration form and return it to the church. The cost of the Festival is \$8 for each participant for the first event/category plus \$4 for each additional event/category the participant would like to enter. Everyone must pre-register by February 9. No late registrations will be accepted due to scheduling purposes.

I hope you will make every effort to encourage your child to participate in the Junior Fine Arts Festival. With God's help, together we can empower the next generation of ministers.

VOCAL MUSIC

Categories:

Female Solo, Male Solo, Ensemble (8 kids or under), Choir (over 8 kids)

Rules:

1. Christian music must be used for vocal music ministry.
2. Any accompaniment instrument is acceptable, including Tape or CD. Background vocals are permitted only for vocal soloists.
3. A five-minute time limit will be imposed for each presentation.
4. Words and music should be memorized (vocals only).
5. Children's choirs should sing the song as a choir. If there is a solo part, it should be minimal.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Chose a song that was not too high or too low for your voice.
2. Kept with the rhythm of the song.
3. Projected your voice.
4. Pronounced your words clearly.
5. Used facial expressions to express emotion.
6. Looked at the audience.
7. Had a friendly smile.
8. Used your hands to express emotions.
9. Presented yourself with a calm and good attitude on stage.
10. Ministered effectively.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

Categories:

Instrumental Solo, Instrumental Duet, Instrumental Group

Rules:

1. For this category Christian music is suggested but not required.
2. The instrument played by the participant cannot be used on the accompaniment tape/CD.
3. A five-minute time limit will be imposed for each presentation.
4. Music should be memorized.
5. Festival coordinators are only required to provide a piano and a portable audio system for participants using accompaniment tracks. All other instruments will be provided by the participant.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Played the notes clearly.
2. Kept the exact rhythm.
3. Played loud and soft at the appropriate times.
4. Remembered the music.
5. Played the correct notes.
6. Used good posture.
7. Presented yourself with a calm and good attitude on stage.
8. Smiled at the audience before and after you played.
9. Played within the time limit.
10. Ministered effectively.

CREATIVE MOVEMENT

Categories:

Sticks Solo, Sticks Group, Sign Language Solo, Sign Language Group

Rules:

1. Movements should flow smoothly and correlate with the intensity of the music.
2. The use of sets and props is permitted (excluding backdrops).
3. The use of costumes is permitted. A costume is considered any outfit or makeup that is worn to create the appearance which is characteristic of a particular period, person, place, or thing.
4. Only instrumental tapes/CDs with vocals are permitted for Creative Movement entries. Live accompaniment will not be permitted.
5. Only Christian music will be permitted for Creative Movement entries.
6. A seven-minute time limit will be imposed for each presentation, with a three-minute limit for setup.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Kept good timing with the music.
2. Used appropriate body movement/props to interpret the song.
3. Were confident and prepared to minister.
4. Remembered your parts.
5. Displayed creativity and originality.
6. Stayed focused.
7. Presented yourself with a calm and good attitude on stage.
8. Used facial expressions to communicate emotions.
9. Smiled at the audience at appropriate time.
10. Ministered effectively.

DRAMA

Categories:

Drama Solo, Drama Group, Clowning Solo, Clowning Group, Mime Solo, Mime Group

Rules:

1. Any verbal communication during drama presentations must be memorized, including Scripture quotation.
2. The use of sets (excluding backdrops) and props is permitted. A prop is considered any item (including article of clothing) manipulated in any way by a character. Any item used to suggest scenery qualifies as a prop.
3. The wearing of costumes is permitted. A costume is considered any outfit or makeup that is worn to create the appearance which is characteristic of a particular period, person, place, or thing.
4. The use of instrumental audio tapes/CD (without vocals or background vocals) is permitted for drama entries.
5. A seven-minute time limit will be imposed for each presentation, with a three-minute limit for setup.
6. The theme of the Junior Fine Arts Festival should be reflected in all drama categories.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Stayed focused.
2. Were confident and prepared to minister.
3. Remembered your parts.
4. Efficiently portrayed your character(s).
5. Conveyed the meaning of the presentation.
6. Introduced, developed, and concluded the drama.
7. Used facial and body movements to communicate emotions.
8. Smiled at the audience at appropriate times.
9. Presented yourself with a calm and good attitude on stage.
10. Ministered effectively.

HUMAN VIDEO

Categories:

Human Video Solo, Human Video Group

Rules:

1. The musical track must include lyrics.
2. The use of sets and props (excluding backdrops) is permitted. A prop is considered any item manipulated in any way by a character or used to suggest scenery. The participant(s) must keep in mind the amount of time they will have to set up for the presentation.
3. Human video entries will be allowed the use of costumes.
4. Only Christian instrumental audiotapes and CDs with vocals are permitted for Human Video entries. Live accompaniment will not be permitted.
5. Human Video presentations may include "lip sync."
6. No live vocal communication of any form from the actor(s) will be allowed for Human Video.
7. A seven-minute limit will be imposed for each presentation, with a three-minute maximum limit for setup.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Appropriately introduced, developed, and concluded the presentation.
2. Stayed with the music and/or group.
3. Was confident and prepared to minister.
4. Represented your character(s) well.
5. Conveyed the meaning of the song.
6. Used facial and body movements to communicate emotions.
7. Presented yourself on stage.
8. Smiled at the audience at appropriate times.
9. Used appropriate Christian music that included lyrics.
10. Ministered effectively.

PUPPETRY

Categories:

Puppetry Solo, Puppetry Group

Rules:

1. Puppetry may use recorded music or dialogue (Christian music must be used), or live puppet skit.
2. Props may be used, including but not limited to black lights and strobes.
3. Puppet stage, black lights, and strobes will be provided by the participant.
4. Set-up time is three minutes. There will be a five-minute time limit for each presentation.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Used props, black lights, sounds and/or signs well.
2. Kept the puppet head from going back while opening mouth.
3. Made the puppet make frequent eye contact with the audience.
4. Entered and exited the stage like going up and down stairs.
5. Moved the puppets body to express emotion.
6. Kept your puppet above the stage without sinking.
7. Made your puppet seem real.
8. Made the mouth open and close with the words.
9. Used appropriate Christian music that included lyrics or Christian skit.
10. Ministered effectively.

COMMUNICATION

Categories:

Bible Memorization, Object Lesson, Short Sermon, Gospel Illusion

Rules:

1. Only one participant at a time may participate in this category.
2. For Bible memorization, the Scripture verses are Romans 11:33-36:1-7. If the New International Version (NIV) is not used, please bring three copies of your version for the judges.
3. Object lessons, short sermons, and gospel illusions should correspond with the Festival theme.
4. The content of the message must be scripturally accurate.
5. Participants presenting a short sermon may use notes. However, using notes should not hinder eye contact with the audience.
6. There will be a five-minute time limit for each presentation and a three-minute setup limit.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Adequately introduced, developed, and concluded the presentation.
2. Changed voice from loud to soft at proper times.
3. Pronounced words clearly and correctly.
4. Used facial and body movements to communicate emotions.
5. Made eye contact with the audience.
6. Were confident and prepared to minister.
7. Conveyed the meaning of the message.
8. Presented yourself on stage.
9. Smiled at the audience at appropriate times.
10. Ministered effectively.

Categories:

Crafts, Sewing, Baking, Sculpting, Science, Pinewood Derby Cars

Rules:

1. Each creation must include a 100–200 word report telling why the creation was made and how it was used to minister to someone.
2. The participant's name and church address must be attached to the entry or report.
3. The entry must be brought to the Junior Fine Arts Festival presentation room at the time designated by the regional official.
4. The entry must be picked up after the Festival. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is not responsible for entries left behind.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Creatively displayed your creation.
2. Used proper grammar on the report.
3. Described the purpose of your project.
4. Reflected the Festival theme.
5. Neatly wrote or carefully typed your report.
6. Put a lot of effort and details in your work.
7. Showed uniqueness and originality.
8. Used your imagination to be creative.
9. Displayed your name and church address.
10. Ministered effectively.

VISUAL ARTS

Categories:

Painting, Collages, Posters, Drawing, Photography

Rules:

1. Entries must be mounted. The overall size, including mounting, must not exceed 24" x 24."
2. Artwork must follow the Festival theme.
3. The child's name and address must be attached to the artwork.
4. The entry must be brought to the Junior Fine Arts Festival presentation room at the time designated by the regional official.
5. The entry must be picked up after the Festival. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is not responsible for entries left behind.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Displayed your artwork.
2. Had interesting designs, backgrounds, or depth.
3. Had many lines, curves, and /or shapes.
4. Used color and/or shadows.
5. Put a lot of effort and details into your work.
6. Reflected the Festival theme.
7. Showed uniqueness and originality.
8. Used your imagination to be creative.
9. Displayed your name and church address.
10. Ministered effectively.

CREATIVE WRITING

Categories:

Short Story, Poetry

Rules:

1. Short story may have a minimum of 100 and maximum of 400 words.
2. Poetry may be rhymed or free verse with a maximum of 25 lines.
3. Entries must be typed, double spaced, with at least one-inch margin on all sides.
4. Entries must be on 8.5 x 11 white paper.
5. A separate title page should include the title, author's name, church name, and church location.
6. The child's name and church address must be attached to the entry.
7. The entry must be brought to the Junior Fine Arts Festival presentation room at the time designated by the regional official.
8. The entry must be picked up after the Festival. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is not responsible for entries left behind.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Adequately introduced, developed, and ended your writing.
2. Used descriptive words.
3. Put a lot of effort and details into your work.
4. Used proper grammar and spelling.
5. Typed correctly.
6. Expressed Festival theme.
7. Used your words to paint a picture in the mind of the reader.
8. Showed uniqueness and originality.
9. Displayed your name and church address.
10. Ministered effectively.

MINISTRY DISPLAY

Categories:

Missions Display, Outreach Display

For this category the children can choose between researching a country or missionary. They may choose to tell about various needs and missionary efforts that are in the area or they may choose to give tribute to a particular missionary through their display.

Rules:

1. The display must be on a tri-fold display board.
2. There must be a map showing where the country is located.
3. Information about the country, missionary, or missionaries that minister in the country must be provided. The information provided must be between 200 to 400 words.
4. Pictures of the country and missionaries in that country should be on the display.
5. The participants name and church address must be attached to the display.
6. The entry must be brought to the Junior Fine Arts Festival presentation room at the time designated by the official.
7. The entry must be picked up after the Festival. The Junior Fine Arts Festival is not responsible for entries left behind.

Evaluation Guidelines:

1. Creatively displayed your creation.
2. Used proper grammar on the report.
3. Described the purpose of your project.
4. Reflected the Festival theme.
5. Neatly wrote or carefully typed your report.
6. Put a lot of effort and details in your work.
7. Showed uniqueness and originality.
8. Used your imagination to be creative.
9. Displayed your name and church address.
10. Ministered effectively.
