I am excited about 2009 and the events planned for the Kit Carson Chapter. A few weeks ago we had a planning meeting in order to have all the FCF planned out. Here is a run down of what is happening:

- Pathfinder trip to Mexico: May 15 – 22, 2009. Tom Holden is coordinating this trip. The cost is \$850. Get your registration in soon.
- Utah Section Camp: May 29-31. Hucks Hollow, UT.
- Trace: June 5-7th. Winding River Resort in Grand Lake, CO Camp Fee \$25.00

- District Camp: July 23-26. Get information at www.rmdrr.org
- Family Camp: Sep. 4-7. We are still working on the location for this camp.

We are working on putting together a bronze Pathfinder Trip to Riggins, ID next year. A church is building a camp for youth, Girls Ministries, Royal Rangers and more. This will be a great opportunity to help a neighboring district for an inexpensive fee. More information to come.

We are also looking at Family Camp overall and need some input from all FCF Members and their wives (if they have one).

A reminder that this year FCF will be having two Frontier Adventures; one at Trace and one at District Camp. There is an FCF Application form in the www.rmdrr.org website for anyone that wants to join FCF. I will need the applications early so I can get the information to the applicants on what they need to bring - when and where they need to arrive at camp. The cost to attend a Frontier Adventure is \$25.00 per person; if you are wanting to advance to buckskin or wilderness then an application needs to be turned in for that as well. Buckskin is \$25.00 and Wilderness is \$35.00

A few key things that changed: FCF is no longer collecting dues every year. However, this is a ministry and it costs money to hold the events, have prizes for competitions etc., so FCF will accept donations to the ministry. We really need your help here, however we will not beg.

FCF is also allowing former FCF members to attend Trace and other FCF events. There are many reasons why someone may not be attached to an outpost, however they have a passion for FCF. So if you know someone that was once part of FCF and they would like to attend Trace, invite them.

As a planning tool we will have a Trace registration form. This is very similar to the District Camp Registration. Yes, it will require a Pastors signature for adults, or if you are not attending a church, it will require a signature from someone in FCF.
