The Brethouwer Story:

At the age of 24, as a young father, husband, and rancher, Kenneth Brethouwer accepted the Lord's call to the ministry. He and his first wife Lola pastored in Stoneham, Colorado from 1941 until 1952. Then they moved to Ogden, Utah where they pastored Canyon Road Assembly of God. Lola passed away in 1962, leaving behind Kenneth and their five daughters.

Bertha Mae Blair answered God's call on her life at an early age and got her start in ministry preaching in schoolhouses in Oklahoma and Arkansas. She formed the Blair Evangelistic Trio and traveled throughout the West and Midwest, evangelizing.

She was ordained by the Assemblies of God in 1942, and over the next 20 years served as a missionary and Christian Education Director at a church in Hawaii. They were married in 1964.

Reverend Brethouwer put his craftsman skills to good use helping construct a new building while at Canyon Road Assembly of God in Ogden and also assisting Rock Canyon Assemblies of God in Provo, Utah with their building.

In 1973, Kenneth and Bertha Mae flew to Africa where he supervised a building project and she taught in the Bible School.

In 1979, the Brethouwers retired in Provo where they remained active members of Rock Canyon Worship Center, currently known as Genesis Project, Provo.

The Brethouwer daughters, along with Rock Canyon Worship Center, established The Brethouwer Scholarship Fund. The Rocky Mountain Ministry Network is pleased to carry on their legacy by assisting those students who wish to answer God's call on their lives as well.

Brethouwer Scholarship Criteria

All applications are to be sent in to the Secretary/Treasurer. He shall maintain an accurate file of all applications.

The following is a guide and listed in order of preference:

1) A follower of Jesus Christ

2) College/University students regularly attending Genesis Project, Provo will be given preference.

Genesis Project, Provo has a Brethouwer Scholarship Committee which will make their collective recommendation to the Secretary/Treasurer for consideration.

3) Upper Classmen

A senior who has not been a recipient of the Brethouwer Scholarship in previous years may receive preference over lower classmen. However, a freshman or sophomore may be considered when all other requirements are met. We want to encourage freshmen and sophomores to apply! This scholarship is reserved for undergraduates. The student may be eligible to receive multiple scholarships over his/her years in college. Each school year a new application will be required.

4) GPA of at least 2.5 will only serve as a qualifier for the scholarship.

The Brethouwer Scholarship is not an academic scholarship and is given in loving memory of Kenneth and Bertha Mae Brethouwer.

5) Current ministry involvement

Although attending a Christian University is not a prerequisite for being awarded this scholarship, we are looking for students that are engaged in either church or campus ministry.
