# ways to serve your campus

- 1 MEET THE PRINCIPAL**  
Even if you have nothing to offer at this time, stop by or make an appointment to introduce yourself. If you already know ways you can volunteer, offer those ideas.
- 2 CONNECT WITH SCHOOL COUNSELORS**  
If you have troubled students in your youth group, connecting with a school counselor is a great way of building a safety net under that student while working together.
- 3 BE PRESENT AT SCHOOL EVENTS**  
The school personnel will get to know you and the students will start to recognize you.
- 4 DISCOVER A NEED AND FILL IT**
  - Go to a school board meeting and listen.
  - Ask others about school needs *ie: help with baccalaureate, provide sound, video and lights, etc. for graduation, painting a classroom*

## FIVE VOLUNTEER TO COACH A TEAM

- 11 COLLECT SCHOOL SUPPLIES**  
Coordinate with the school to deliver backpacks and school supplies to underserved students.

**TWELVE FILL LUNCH BAGS**  
Fill backpacks/bags with food for weekend meals. Make sure to coordinate with the school.

- 13 WORK WITH YOUR STUDENTS TO CLEAN UP TRASH AFTER SCHOOL EVENTS**  
School staff will take notice.
- 14 BE CONSISTENT**  
Have regular interaction with the school.
- TEACH YOUR STUDENTS TO BE RESPECTFUL OF STAFF AND TEACHERS**  
Teach them to show appreciation to faculty and other students. Staff will recognize them and where they come from.

- 19 ADD VALUE TO THE SCHOOL BY VOLUNTEERING**  
Website and social media, computer skills, construction, automotive, music, drama
- 20 LOOK FOR A PAID POSITION**  
*ie: bus driver, music lessons, coaching, tutoring or mentoring*

- DESIGN & PRINT SHIRTS, HOODIES OR OTHER SPORTSWEAR FOR A TEAM AT SCHOOL**
- 22 EVERYBODY LOVES FREE FOOD:**
  - Meals at conference time, beginning of school and in-service days
  - Supply snacks for PTA meetings, ACT or honors program
  - Lunch for drama, speech competition, band, choir, etc...
- 23 HONOR A SPECIFIC SCHOOL AT YOUR YOUTH GROUP**  
Each quarter, have a gift, scholarship or donation of equipment for the school.

- 6 SUBSTITUTE TEACH**
- 7 SERVE IN THE LUNCHROOM**  
Contact the school for ways you can serve in the lunchroom. This creates both trust and favor.
- 8 OFFER YOUR CHURCH BUILDING FOR SPECIAL DISTRICT EVENTS**
- 9 BRING GIFTS TO OFFICE STAFF**  
Consider bringing gift cards, fresh coffee, or gift certificates to local businesses.
- 10 HELP WITH CAMPUS GROUPS**  
Assist student leaders, attend their events and offer to speak when needed.

- 16 GIVE A WELCOME CARD AND GIFT CARD TO TEACHERS**
- 17 HOST A TEACHER'S APPRECIATION DINNER**  
Host at your church with a catered meal, gifts, awards, etc. Make it easy to attend during the week.
- 18 BRING IN SCHOOL ASSEMBLY SPEAKER AND PAY FOR IT**  
This pays huge dividends in the long run. It builds bridges that remain strong and creates favor that brings new opportunity to serve your school.

- 24 HONOR PRINCIPALS, TEACHERS, COACHES OR STUDENTS**
